Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF)

What is SCQF?

The SCQF is a way of comparing Scottish qualifications to other qualification frameworks. It does this by giving each qualification a level and a number of credit points.

The level of a qualification shows how difficult the learning is.

The credit points show how much learning is involved in achieving that qualification.

The Professional Diploma in Business Administration is at Level 11 and credit rated at master's degree Level.

The table below shows a rough comparison of the levels on the the Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF),

European Qualifications Framework (EQF), the Regulated Qualifications Framework (RQF) and the Credit and Qualifications Framework for Wales (CQFW).
